





Rowing Clinic for Athletes with Intellectual Disabilities

Louisville Adaptive Rowing – June 5-9, 2013

This 4-day clinic is open to all athletes, men and women, with intellectual disabilities. Athletes who show particular promise may be invited to participate at a higher level.

The camp will be held at **Louisville Adaptive Rowing**, one of the premier adaptive rowing facilities in the United States.

Head Coach: 2012 Paralympic Coach Bobby Hurley

Camp Fee: \$250 - \$350 per athlete (depending on funding) for the 4 days, including intensive, focused coaching; most meals; all rowing equipment; facility usage and offwater activities and housing at the University of Louisville.

Clinic participants are limited to 20 athletes; applicants must meet the requirements listed below:

Camp eligibility requirements (must be submitted with registration):

- Evidence of intellectual disability (Medical report, IEP, IQ tests, etc.)
- Rowing experience (novices welcome)
- Evidence of fitness and ability to tread water for 5 minutes
- Ability to travel independently, without coach, parent or chaperone
- Minimum age: 16
